





# Integrated Pest Management for Faculty

**WE ALL HAVE A ROLE IN PREVENTING PESTS**

<b>1 REDUCE CLUTTER!</b> (If you haven't used it in 2 years, discard it!)	<b>HOW TO PREVENT THAT BUG?!</b>			
<b>2 KEEP ALL FOOD IN TIGHT-SEALED CONTAINERS</b> (Those with snap-on lids)	<b>ants</b> 	Keep food and/or liquids in a specified area and stored in tight-sealed containers. Report recurring ants, and do not use sprays!		
<b>3 EMPTY TRASH &amp; RECYCLING DAILY</b> (Consider "keep the bag, dump the trash")		<b>roaches</b> 	Change corrugated cardboard for plastic bins. Eliminate clutter. Keep food and art supplies with glue in tight-sealed containers. Sanitize food area.	
<b>4 KEEP COATS, PACKS, ETC., IN DESIGNATED AREA</b> (Pests hitchhike!)	<b>mice</b> 		Thoroughly clean and organize storage areas, shelves, etc., 2-3 times a year. Report droppings and holes $\geq \frac{3}{4}$ " around corners or doors, keep eating areas clean and food sealed.	
<b>5 CLEAN SPILLS THOROUGHLY AND MINIMIZE FOOD DEBRIS</b> (Pests will quickly find food & drink!)				<b>crickets</b> 
<b>6 DO NOT USE CARDBOARD BOXES FOR STORAGE</b> (They house and feed a number of pest species!)	<b>7 REPORT PESTS - USE YOUR PEST SIGHTING LOGS!</b> (Talk to your IPM staff to learn where these are located)			
<b>8 DISCOURAGE FERAL ANIMALS</b> (Do not feed feral cats or dogs, especially near buildings and playgrounds.)			<b>9 REPORT MAINTENANCE &amp; SANITATION ISSUES</b> (Especially leaking water!)	
<b>10 INCORPORATE CURRICULA ON INSECTS TO INVOLVE STUDENTS</b>
