Undergraduate student (2.5 months, \$3,000) to set and collect traps in the field, count insects on the traps, and record these in the database.

Technician (.2 FTE, \$7,000). Oversees the undergraduate student, writes the educational fact sheet, posts it on the website, and performs laboratory functions necessary to the project.

B. Fringe Benefits: \$4,430 total
