

Significant Changes

Washington:

- Continued BMSB damage in Vancouver
 - Peaches, apples, peppers, French pumpkins
- Yakima County now considered to have established populations
 - Increasing threat to important pome and stone fruit growers
- King County
 - The first two documented finds of BMSB suggest established populations already present
 - Increasing threat to small fruit growers in Western WA
 - Increasing probability of spread from major urban area

Significant Changes

- Oregon
 - No new Counties
 - More grower finds or damage
 - hazelnut, wine grapes, tree fruits
 - First BMSB damage in blueberries
 - Willamette Valley
 - Considerable increase in homeowner complaints
 - Range and volume
 - Long, extended dry season
 - Many BMSB from 2nd gen able to attain adult stage
 - First major aggregations south of Salem in the Willamette Valley



Significant Changes

- Idaho
 - Confirmed find in AdaCounty
 - Near Treasure Valley
 - OR/ID growing region
 - Field /specialty crops
 - Possibly established populations in Boise
 - Unconfirmed reports



California

- Many new reports
- No commercial damage known
- Backyard fruit/veg damage or urban nuisance problems
 - LA County
 - Sacramento Area
